I-14 Central Texas Corridor study

The TxDOT Bryan District is studying the future I-14 Central Texas Corridor from Rogers in Bell County to Huntsville in Walker County. This study will determine the feasibility of a route for a roadway that meets interstate standards. This notice advises the public that TxDOT is hosting a third round of six in-person open houses with a virtual option for the ongoing study.

All six open houses will contain the same study information and exhibits. Attendees are welcome to come and go as they please to review informational displays and ask questions of staff in an open house format. The purpose of the public meeting is to present a study update and receive public comments.

**The virtual open house option will make available the information presented, including meeting materials and exhibits.** The virtual option is **not** a live broadcast event. Meeting materials can be viewed online on the TxDOT website, [www.txdot.gov](http://www.txdot.gov), keyword search “I-14 Central Texas” starting at 4:30 p.m. on Tuesday, August 11, 2026. If you do not have internet access, you may call the I-14 Central Texas Corridor study Project Team at 979-484-7358 between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, to ask questions and access project materials during the study process.

The I-14 Central Texas Corridor Study aligns with ongoing statewide I-14 development and planning efforts to ensure consistency and continuity of the interstate corridor from west Texas to Louisiana. Additionally, the study includes evaluation of the designated future Loop I-214 around the Cities of Bryan and College Station, which is anticipated to co-align with I-14 as it passes through the Bryan-College Station area.

In Fall 2023, TxDOT held the first round of open houses and obtained feedback from local communities within the study area. A second round of open houses was held in Summer 2024 to collect feedback from local communities about opportunity areas, which helped guide development of conceptual alternative routes. The third round of open houses will introduce these route concepts for the future I-14 corridor. The public will be able to provide feedback on the route concepts in any of the six open houses or online.

The in-person open house and project materials will be in English. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English is not your primary language or have difficulty communicating in English, one will be provided to you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs. If you need interpretation or translation services or are a person with a disability who requires an accommodation to attend and participate in the in-person open houses or virtual option, please contact the I-14 Central Texas Corridor Study Team at 979-484-7358 no later than three days prior to a specific meeting date noted above. Please be aware that advance notice is required as some services and accommodations may require time to arrange.
